

Arlington Heights Memorial Day Parade Information and Map

The Buffalo Grove High School "Bison Pride" Marching Band always participates in this annual event. It is always on Memorial Day (Monday) at the end of the three day holiday weekend and starts at 9:30 AM. Students are to wear their white blouses, marching band pants, black shoes, and black socks. Tennis shoes, walking shoes, boat shoes, sandals, or any other footwear can cause a student to be removed from the parade line-up.

The parade starts on Sigwalt, about 3-4 blocks east of Arlington Hts. Road. Sigwalt is the first stop light south of the railroad tracks off of Arlington Heights Road. We meet at our designated spot on Sigwalt at 9:00 AM. Students who wish to go to the band room are to be there by 8:15 AM.

The parade goes west on Sigwalt to Dunton where it turns north (right) to Euclid where it goes west again (left) for four more blocks to Chestnut where it goes south (left) for three blocks and breaks up one block north of Northwest Highway (Rt 14). Students are to be picked up at this location. If transportation is a hardship for someone, transportation will be provided if requested. It will be assumed that students who depart at the end of the parade route will not need any assistance.

The parade should break-up about 10:15 AM. Hopefully this information will be helpful to everyone. See the map below for visual details.
